

The **Planned Activities Committee** wants to make sure all Maryland Job's Daughters, MD GGC Members, Guests and Family Members are aware of the events taking place during the Grand Session weekend. We invite you to join us whenever possible. Please complete the registration form for those Daughters who wish to participate in the weekend's activities.

Rules and Regulations

Deadline for entering Activities: The Bethel registration forms must be mailed or emailed and received no later than April 10, 2009, or they may be turned into Mom Cathy Feyen or Dad John Jordan at Spring Banquet. Registration is required for all activities.

General Rules:

1. The Daughters must complete all work. However we do know that sometimes because of Bethel size some of the parents and council members will assist/teach our daughters. But let's try to keep it to teaching and verbal help and less hands-on help.
2. All sashed, (registered with the GGC) Jobie-to-Bees are eligible to participate in all activities.
3. The judges and chairperson's decisions are final.

Digital Scavenger Hunt: The daughters will pick up their information and SD cards at Spring Banquet from Mom Cathy or Dad John.

- Each Bethel team that wishes to participate needs to bring a digital camera that takes a standard size SD card (mini SD cards will not work).
- Cell phone cameras cannot be used.
- The complete set of rules will be explained when you pick up the SD card at Spring Banquet.
- One Entry per Bethel.
- Entries are due to Mom Cathy Friday night at the Laser Tag and Miniature Golf activity by 11:00 pm.
- Some of the pictures will be shown in a slide show on Saturday.

Pool Party: Daughters and Guests may swim from 8 – 10:00 PM at the Princess Royale indoor pool on Thursday evening. Light snacks will be available. Jobie appropriate swim wear and a Chaperone are required for the pool party.

Door Decorations: The door decoration paper (along with "special tape") can be picked up in the dining hall right after breakfast between 8:30 am and 9:00 am on Friday morning.

- Each door's theme should reflect the Grand Guardian and Associate Grand Guardian's Term Themes.
- Each daughter room may decorate a door.
- All decorations should have a cut out allowing for the "peep hole" to be visible for security reasons.
- Please bring all the materials you might need to decorate your doors.
- Entries will be judged Saturday after 1:00 p.m.

Bethel Banners: Banners are due in the dining hall right after breakfast between 8:30 am and 9:00 am on Friday morning. If a Bethel cannot get their banner there this early, they must call us ahead of time so we can make special arrangements.

- The theme for banners is “Promoting your Bethel”.
- There shall be only one entry per Bethel.
- The Bethels Number must appear on the front design of the Banner.
- Overall dimensions of the banner must not exceed 3 feet by 5 feet.
- No part of the banner can protrude out or be thicker than 3 inches.
- The banners must have a hem for hanging and each Bethel must provide a pole for hanging.
- Be careful with copyrighted materials.

Bethel Badges: Badges are due in the dining hall right after breakfast between 8:30 am and 9:00 am on Friday morning. The overall design for the badge should be something unique to your bethel. There is no specific theme.

- There shall be only one entry per Bethel.
- The design may be the Bethel’s choice in keeping with the ideals of Job’s Daughters.
- The Bethel number must be visible on the badge.
- The badges must be worn by all Bethel members and their guests throughout the weekend.
- The badge must not be larger than 4 inches by 4 inches and should be no smaller than 2 ½ inches by 2 ½ inches.
- Please be careful of copyrighted materials.
- Please make sure that you submit two badges, one for Mom Bunny and one for Dad Scott. Please insure that the two badges submitted mirror the other badges worn by the other bethel members and their guests/families.

Table Decorations: Table Decorations are due in the dining hall right after breakfast between 8:30 am and 9:00 am on Friday morning.

- There shall be up to 2 entries per Bethel.
- The theme should reflect the Grand Guardian and Associate Grand Guardian’s Mascots.
- The Bethel number must be visible on the decoration.
- Each decoration should be no larger than a 12 inch dinner plate.
- Please be careful of copyrighted materials.
- These decorations will be placed on the tables in the dining room for the enjoyment for all to see at dinner Friday and breakfast Saturday.

Jobie Olympics: Jobie Olympics will be held in the meeting room from 9:00 am to 10:30 am. As with the US Olympic Team, each different event can have team entries or individual entries.

Ritual Refresher: Ritual Refresher will be held in the meeting room from 10:30 am to 11:30 am. Mom Gina Jordan and the Grand Bethel Officer will perform the Ritual Refresher for the Daughters and Adults. Daughters and Bethel Guardians this event is Mandatory.

Lunch: A light lunch will be served from 11:45 am to 12:30 pm in the Atrium. Be sure to join in the fun as this is a great opportunity to get acquainted with others from around the State.

Laser Tag and Miniature Golf with DJ: On Friday night we will be going to Planet Maze on 33rd Street to play Laser Tag or Miniature Golf while enjoying the sounds of DJ-Frankie Hein. This will start immediately following formal opening (around 9:30 PM and end at midnight). We will serve pizza, snacks and drinks. Jobies and out of state visitors are free. There will be a fee (TBA) for all Adults, Chaperones, other Masonic Youth and Other Guests. The DeMolay must provide their own chaperones. Advance registration is required.

Miss Grand Session: Saturday just before the Choral and Talent Competition, will be holding the Miss Grand Session contest.

- Please insure that your contestant is in the meeting room for registration between 8:30 am and 8:45 am. The contest will begin promptly at 9:00 am.
- This year's theme will be "It's a Small World After All".
- There shall be only 1 contestant per Bethel.
- The contestant **MUST be a Male that is 15 years old or older.**
- All contestants must have an introduction written and turned in at the time of registration.

Please remember that all performances, choice of material, props and costumes shall be in good taste and in keeping with the ideals of Job's Daughters.

Dance: After Installation on Saturday we will dance the night away (at least until 11:00 PM) our favorite DJ, Frankie Hein. Drinks and snacks will be served.
