

Planned Activities Rules and Regulations 2011

The Planned Activities Committee wants to make sure all Maryland Job's Daughters, MD GGC Members, guests and family members are aware of the events taking place during the Grand Session weekend. We invite you to join us whenever possible. Please complete the registration form for those Daughters who wish to participate in the weekend's activities.

Deadline for entering Activities: The Bethel registration forms must be mailed or emailed no later than April 9, 2011, or they may be turned into a committee member at Spring Banquet. Registration is required for all activities.

1. The Daughters must complete all work. However we do know that sometimes because of Bethel size some of the parents and council members will assist and teach our Daughters. Let's try to keep it to teaching and verbal help and less hands-on help.
2. All sashed, (registered with the GGC) Jobie-to-Bees are eligible to participate in all activities.
3. The judges and/or committee's decisions are final.
4. All Planned Activities Awards will be awarded at the Banquet on Saturday night.

Pool Party: Daughters may swim together from 8:00 – 10:00 p.m. at the Princess Royale indoor pool on Thursday evening. Drinks will be available in the atrium area. Jobie appropriate swim wear and a Chaperone are required for the pool party. No bare midriffs and Daughters must have a cover-up when going to and from the pool. Please keep in mind that we do not have exclusive access to the pool and that other hotel guests may be present.

Scavenger Hunt: The Daughters will pick up their information and SD cards on Friday morning at 8:00 a.m. Entries are due by 10:00 p.m. on Friday night at laser tag & mini golf. Each Bethel team that wishes to participate needs to bring a digital camera that takes a standard size SD card (mini SD cards will not work). Cell phone cameras cannot be used. One Entry per Bethel or combined Bethel team (two or more Bethels working together). Some of the pictures may be shown in a slide show during the weekend or at another time.

Door Decorations: Door paper can be picked up Thursday night at 8 p.m. at the pool party or at the Registration Desk on Friday morning at 8 a.m. The theme is "Dream On." Each room may decorate a door. All decorations should have a cut out allowing for the peep hole to be visible for security reasons. Entries will be judged Saturday sometime after 12 p.m. Please bring any materials you may need. Bethels will be provided with paper and painter's tape. Please do not use any other adhesive on doors.

Banners: Banners are due at the Registration Desk at 8:00 a.m. on Friday morning. If your Bethel will not be there on Friday morning, you must contact Stacey Marley (staceymarley@gmail.com or 443-553-6994) to make other arrangements. The theme for banners is promotion. There shall be only one entry per Bethel.

- The Bethel number ***should*** appear on the front design of the Banner.
- Overall dimensions of the banner must not exceed 3 feet by 5 feet.
- No part of the banner can protrude out or be thicker than 3 inches.
- The banners must have a hem for hanging and each Bethel **must** provide a pole for hanging.
- Be careful with copyrighted materials.

Badges: Badges are due at the Registration Desk at 8:00 a.m. on Friday morning. If your Bethel will not be there on Friday morning, you must contact Stacey Marley to make other arrangements. The badges should represent your Bethel in some way, but there is no specific theme.

- There shall be only one entry per Bethel.
- The design may be the Bethel's choice in keeping with the ideals of Job's Daughters.
- The Bethel number may be visible on the badge.
- The badges should be worn by all Bethel members and their guests throughout the weekend.

- The badge must not be larger than 4 inches by 4 inches and should be no smaller than 2 ½ inches by 2 ½ inches.
- Please be careful of copyrighted materials.
- Please make sure that you submit two badges, one for Mom T and one for Dad Mark.

Sand Creations: Friday morning from 9:00 to 10:15 a.m. The theme for sand creations is something that represents your Bethel. One entry will be allowed per Bethel or the combined efforts of two or more Bethels. All work must be completed by 10:15 a.m. You may bring tools, but the finished creation may only include natural items found on the beach. Please also include a brief explanation of your creation and how it represents your Bethel.

Minute to Win It: Teams will compete in a variety of challenges using household items, much like the popular TV show. All materials will be provided. Teams can be 3-5 daughters. Bethels are allowed to have more than one team. There will be 10 games. Each team will pick a player(s) for each game. For each game you will have one minute to complete the task. The first group to complete the task will receive 2 points. Any group that completes the task will receive 1 point. The group with the most points at the end of the 10 games will win.

Laser Tag and Miniature Golf: On Friday night we will be going to Planet Maze on 33rd Street to play Laser Tag or Miniature Golf. This will start immediately following formal opening (around 9:30 pm.). We will serve pizza, snacks and drinks. Jobies and out of state visitors are free. There will be a fee (TBA) for all adults, chaperones, other Masonic youth and other guests. Rainbow and DeMolay members in attendance must provide their own chaperones. Advance registration is required.

Miss Grand Session: Saturday just before the Choral and Talent Competition, we will be holding the Miss Grand Session contest.

- All contestants must register between 8:30 am and 8:45 am. The contest will begin promptly at 9:00 am.
- This year's theme will be "Dream On" and contestants should be dressed as characters from a movie or TV show with the word "dream" in the title.
- There shall be only one entry per Bethel, consisting of one or two male contestants
- All contestants must have an introduction written and turned in at the time of registration
- You may provide music on a CD to be played during the contestant's presentation

Please remember that all performances, choice of material, props and costumes shall be in good taste and in keeping with the ideals of Job's Daughters.

Luau Dance: Saturday we will dance the night away (at least until 11:00 p.m.) to our favorite DJ, Frankie Hein. Please wear Jobie appropriate tropical attire. Drinks and snacks will be served.
