Scholarship Application

The Grand Guardian Council of Maryland is able to provide One Thousand Dollar (\$1,000.00) scholarships to those deserving daughters who are pursuing a post-secondary education.

This scholarship will be paid directly to the college the student will be attending and will be considered a gift if she completes the year of study. If the daughter does not complete the school year, this scholarship is considered a loan and must be repaid to the Grand Guardian Council. The Scholarship committee will consider extenuating circumstances such as extended illness.

High school seniors and those daughters with early admission to college in their senior year may apply. All applicants must have had active membership in Job's Daughters for at least two years at the time of application, have dues paid to majority and have no indebtedness in her Bethel (verified by the Bethel Guardian).

Scholarships will be awarded based on equally weighted criteria:

- Scholastic Aptitude
- Demonstration of leadership ability
- Community / school extra curricular involvement
- Moral Character and work ethic
- Application of the principles of Job's Daughters in chosen career path

Only applications received in their entirety and in proper format by the deadline (as stated in the instructions), will be considered.

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GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLICANTS

1. Applicants must use the forms provided and submit all documents directly to the Chairman of the Scholarship Committee. These documents must be submitted to the Chairman by April 11, 2011. No exceptions will be made for any applicants. Email acknowledgement will be made by the Chairman, so include your e-mail address.
2. Applications must be completely filled out, signed, and verified by the Guardian of the applicant's Bethel. All material will become the property of the Grand Guardian Council and will not be returned. All information will be held in confidence within the committee. All material will be destroyed by October 30th, 2011.
3. Awards are based upon the following equally weighted criteria. Please include all required documentation in a sealed envelope addressed to the committee chairman.

Check each section when complete

___A. ***Scholastic aptitude:*** Provide an official transcript from your high school guidance office which includes courses and grades for sophomore, junior and senior years of high school.

___B. ***Community/school extra-curricular involvement:*** List all extra-curricular activities in the area provided for on page four (4) of this application.

___C. ***Demonstration of leadership ability:*** For each of the activities listed in part B, describe any leadership positions you held and your responsibilities in those positions. You may use the back of page four (4), or an additional sheet of paper if necessary.

___D. ***Moral character and work ethic:*** Provide two (2) letters of recommendation. Each recommendation should attest to the applicant's moral character and work ethic. No references from family members, Executive members of the Grand Guardian Council or Scholarship Committee members will be accepted. Recommendations can be requested from teachers, church leaders, work or volunteer supervisors, organizational advisors or Bethel Guardian Council members. Letters must be typed with date, signature and relationship to the applicant included.

___E. ***Application of the principles of Job's Daughters in chosen career path:*** Candidate must include a 300-500 word essay explaining how her involvement in Job's Daughters has affected her career choice or will be utilized in her chosen career path. Both content and format will be critiqued. Essay must be typed and double spaced using size 12 font.
