#### ANYONE ATTENDING GRAND SESSION MUST BE REGISTERED

Individual forms must be used for each registrant. Bethels and Group Registrations must designate one person authorized to pick up the registration packet at the Registration table. Room keys will be secured with the hotel front desk. No room keys will be distributed via the Session registration table.

#### PAYMENT MUST BE MADE IN FULL IN ORDER TO BE CONSIDERED REGISTERED

It is suggested that your Daughters and adults make their checks payable to your own Bethel. Then issue a SINGLE CHECK payable to the Grand Session 2010 for the entire amount due. If your Bethel desires to create a payment plan, an optional worksheet has been included in the Bethel packet for your convenience. The Session committee can not manage a payment plan for your Bethel, but would be willing to help you establish one in your own Bethel. Note: if there is someone that arrives that is not paid in full, you will NOT receive your Session registration packet and will not be considered a registered guest with the hotel.

#### REGISTRATION CHANGES

If it is necessary to make a change on your registration, send a new registration form marked "Registration Change" with the new information to the Registration Committee Chairman - *Nancy Morris*

#### GRAND BETHEL

Daughters must be registered for Grand Session to be eligible for the Grand Bethel selection taking place at Grand Session. Any other Grand Bethel inquiries must be made with the Grand Bethel Guardian, *Mrs. Kim Miller*.

#### SPECIAL NEEDS

Advise the 2010 Session Arrangement Committee if you or one of your groups require special arrangements. Indicate in the space provided on the registration form. We will have access to handicapped areas, if this is a need, please state so on the registration form. Also, anyone with a need for special meals, please indicate that as well. All will receive a non smoking room unless stated otherwise on the registration form.

#### IDENTIFICATION BADGES MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES

No one will be admitted to the Grand Guardian Council meeting, Grand Bethel meeting, or any meals without a badge. One Day and Three Day passes are available for Visitors and/or Guests. If meals are requested for anyone with a day pass, these meals must be pre-registered. Note, some times meal tickets are not used by some with full packages; however, this cannot be guaranteed. Please reserve a meal if you are coming and are utilizing a day pass and wish to participate in the group meals.

#### CHAPERONES AND CONDUCT - *please see hotel rules*

ALL DAUGHTERS 20 years of age and younger must be chaperoned throughout the entire Grand Session. The safety and well being of the Daughters is the major concern at Session. Daughters are expected to cooperate with any adults in the chaperoning capacity - whether it be from their own Bethels or not. (*Remember the ratio: one adult per five Daughters*)

#### CLIMATE

#### From Pittsburgh International Airport

Follow Route 60 South to Interstate 79 North. Take Exit 76 (exit from left) and merge onto State Route 19 North. Proceed to the first light and turn right onto Freeport Road. Continue 1 block, turn right onto Sheraton Drive.

#### From East

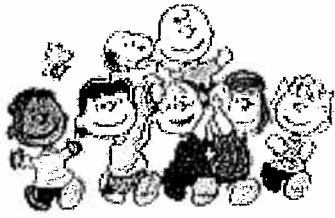
Take the Pennsylvania Turnpike to Exit 28 (Cranberry). Turn right and take Route 19 South to the first intersection, Turn left onto Freeport Road. At the first intersection, then turn right onto Sheraton Drive.

#### From North

Take I-79 South to Exit 78. Exit right to the first intersection and turn left. Take Route 19 South and travel .5 miles to the 3rd light. Turn left on Freeport Road. Proceed 1 block to the intersection and turn right onto Sheraton Drive.

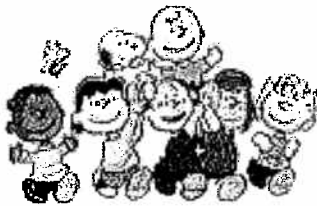
